Modern freelancing activities take place on freelance platforms, which are online marketplaces that connect businesses with freelance professionals all over the world.

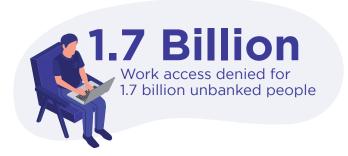

OUR SOLUTIONS

For Freelancers: Zero fees and membership costs so freelancers keep 100% of what they earn.

For Companies: Protect the budget. Agencies mark up talent with 60-70%. At Lanceria we charge a flat 4% in crypto or 8% in Fiat.

Smart contracts: blockchain technology and smart contracts to foster trust between sellers and buyers and work as their employment agreements.

On-chain Escrow for settlements: Freelancers have the guarantee of payment for their services, while the Employer's funds are safely stored in the smart contract until the Freelancer produces the expected work.

User & Portfolio verification - reliable biometric KYC mechanism.

Matchmaking: Matching skills and reputation with requirements, with Machine learning.

Transparency: By implementing an automated dispute system and reputation stored on the blockchain.

Affiliate program: We scale earning opportunities by enabling users to earn 20% of escrowed jobs their affiliates make through the platform.

Exclusive training, mentorship, learn-to-earn, on -chain credentials and community rewards for activities, reputation and accomplishments.

Medical and retirement plans.

Dedicated Metaverse for professionals.

TECHNOLOGY

Lanceria is an ever-expanding ecosystem of interconnected freelancers and services, built for a decentralized future. Our **Decentralized App (Dapp)** is developed using Smart Contract technology:

- Decentralized ledger technology (partnership with Chainlink and LinkPool)
- Smart contracts for consensus rules
- Decentralized oracle networks
- Verified identity: KYC

We disrupt the industry by using decentralization for payment and identity verification.

Smart contracts cut the middleman. Also, one can use a **digital wallet** if preferred to a credit card.

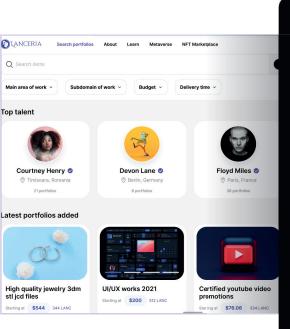

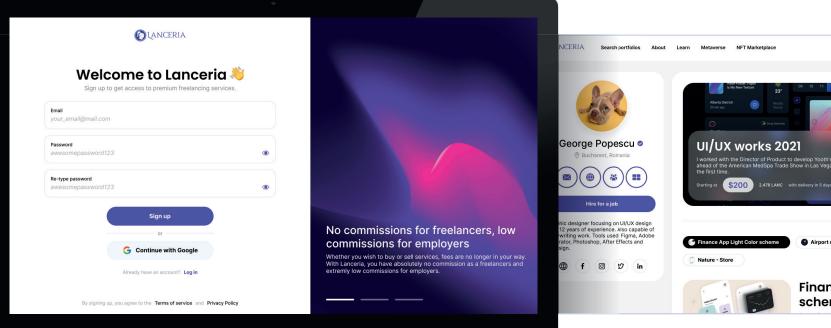


A standardized open API will allow verified users to connect to an immersive virtual work environment

SCALING STRATEGY



THE LAUNCHING POINT IS THE ROMANIAN MARKET:

Currently active 1.2mio freelancers - 36% in IT, 29% in Marketing and Creative services, 19% in Financial Sector and 16% in Other segments.

The digital economy will grow 3.5 times to ~ EUR 52 billion in 2030 vs. EUR 14.8billion in 2021. ICT and Digital Commerce being the main growth drivers, according to the new McKinsey & Company report titled Digital Challengers on the Next Frontier;

Digital Commerce penetration in Romania would need to increase by almost half to reach the level of the Digital Frontrunners (23%), and double to reach global leaders like the UK or China (~30%).

STRATEGY IN A NUTSHELL::

Attracting Freelancers and Customers undertaking specific digital marketing strategies for the freelancing platform.

Stages of adoption - land and expand

First Wave - home markets

Second Wave - established markets

Third Wave - global, especially the unbanked freelancers' segment;

Customers will be targeted by segment: entrepreneurs, startups, SME, and large corporates incl Fortune 500 (e.g. via digital channels, professional associations, workshops, dedicated events, personalized offers etc.)

WORLDWIDE FREELANCING MARKET IN FIGURES

Globally, nearly 70% of freelancers are 35 years or younger (GenZ + Millenials).

Despite the robust growth in freelance work, freelance platforms are responsible for only 1-3% of total global employment. This means there's a significant room for continued growth.

SELF-EMPLOYED

World Bank data shows that 46.4% of all workers worldwide are self-employed, meaning that approximately 1.57 billion people in the global workforce are freelancers, out of a total global workforce of 3.38 billion.

In 2018, the global freelance platforms market was worth \$2.35 billion. In 2020, the value expanded to \$3.38 billion.

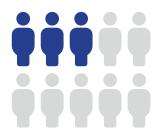

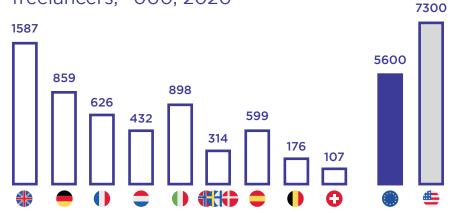

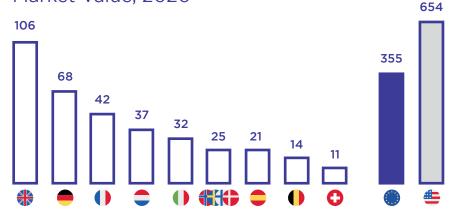

Number of high-skilled freelancers, `000, 2020

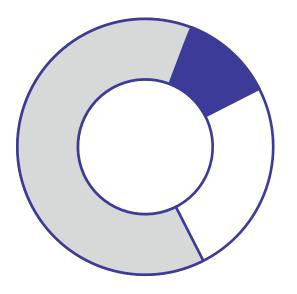


Freelancing Market Value, 2020

Digital professionals and a quarter are freelancers (according to Eurostat)

UK and Italy have among the highest population of freelancers followed by France and the Netherlands and Spain.

Out of the EUR 355Bn EU market value, more than half of the market represents the digital freelancer Marketing & com, Arts & Design, Tech & Data.

ROMANIA'S MARKET POTENTIAL

Romania is the 3rd largest digital economy in CEE and the 2nd largest digital commerce market. Currently, Romania is the 3rd largest digital economy in the Digital Challengers cluster after Poland (44 billion euros) and Czechia (18 billion euros). The value is shared between digital commerce (EUR 9.8billion), expenditures on ICT (EUR 3.5billion) and the EUR 1.6billion offline spending on digital products (e.g., PC, smartphones, IT infrastructure, cloud).

However, Romania's average per capita expenditure on digital commerce and its digital-commerce penetration rate are among the lowest in the region;

Romania's digital economy was estimated at EUR 14.8billion in 2021 – around 6% of GDP (as per McKinsey research). If it reaches the estimated value of EUR 52billion by 2030 – it could account for almost 9.6 % of the GDP in 2030;
